The Conference

Guidelines for Abstracts

The abstract should emphasize the significance of the results and/or major technical merits of the final paper. Abstracts should be approximately 300-400 words in length and must include full names, addresses, telephone, email and fax numbers of the author. In the case of multiple authors, please indicate one primary contact. The official language of IPC 2018 is English.

Review Criteria

Abstracts will be judged on their content emphasizing new knowledge or experiences/test results and their technical merit and interest relative to IPC 2018. Authors must avoid commercial references within their abstracts and full-length papers.
